**BOAR'S HEAD HOSTS THE
ITA NATIONAL WOMEN'S TEAM INDOOR TENNIS CHAMPIONSHIP**

16 of the Nation's Top Collegiate Teams Compete for National Indoor Championship

CHARLOTTESVILLE, Virginia: February 5, 2015 – The 2015 Intercollegiate Tennis Association (ITA) National Women's Team Indoor Championship starts this Friday, February 6 and runs through Monday, February 9, 2015. The University of Virginia will serve as the host of the 28th annual Championship at the Boar's Head Sports Club in Charlottesville, Virginia. The UVA Women's Team will play their first match on Friday at 6:30pm at Boar's Head Sports Club against USC. The public is welcome; come out and show your support at this complimentary event.

“The ITA is delighted to be returning this year to the Boar's Head Sports Club and the University of Virginia for our ITA National Women's Team Indoor Championship,” said ITA Executive Director David A Benjamin. “Their combination of outstanding facilities, professional hospitality, and enthusiastic support makes this a wonderful partnership, and I know that our varsity student-athletes are greatly looking forward to participating in this event.”

Three of the top seeds were ousted as 12 of 15 host teams are advancing to Charlottesville for the right to compete for the prestigious national title. Last year only one top women's seed failed to advance. The 2015 ITA Kick-Off bucked that trend as three group upsets stole the headlines. TCU, Kentucky and Oklahoma State each earned their first bids in program history into the ITA Division I Women's Team Indoor

Championships with upset wins over their host sites. TCU, then ranked No. 41, beat in-state rivals Houston and Texas A&M consecutively to win the group and the bid.

The No. 44 Kentucky Wildcats (now ranked No. 26) became the lowest-ranked women's team to qualify, beating Rice in the semifinal and Arizona State in Sunday's final.

Oklahoma State scored a 4-3 upset in the championship round over the team ranked one spot ahead of it in the national rankings, Georgia Tech. Their proximity in rankings proved nearly precise as the two teams traded leads back-and-forth during the match on the Yellow Jackets' home courts.

Each of the women's top four teams won all their matches in 4-0 shutouts, suggesting the National Team Indoors field will be highly combative. No. 1 UCLA, No. 2 Florida, No. 3 North Carolina and No. 4 Duke will meet host-school No. 10 Virginia and three additional members of the women's Top 10 at the 2015 ITA Division I Women's National Team Indoor Championships from February 6-9.

The event will be held at The Boar's Head Sports Club, recognized by *Tennis Magazine* as a top 50 tennis resort in the United States. In addition to maintaining this Top 50 designation, in 2012, the resort was recognized by *Tennis Magazine* as the #1 Tennis Destination in the mid-Atlantic region. The Boar's Head Sports Club was also named the 2008 Private Facility of the Year by *Racquet Sports Industry Magazine*, while also receiving recognition from *TennisResorts.com* as one of the top 75 tennis resorts in the world. The facility contains a total of 26 courts: 10 Har-Tru outdoor courts, four outdoor hard courts, and 12 state-of-the-art DecoTurf indoor courts.

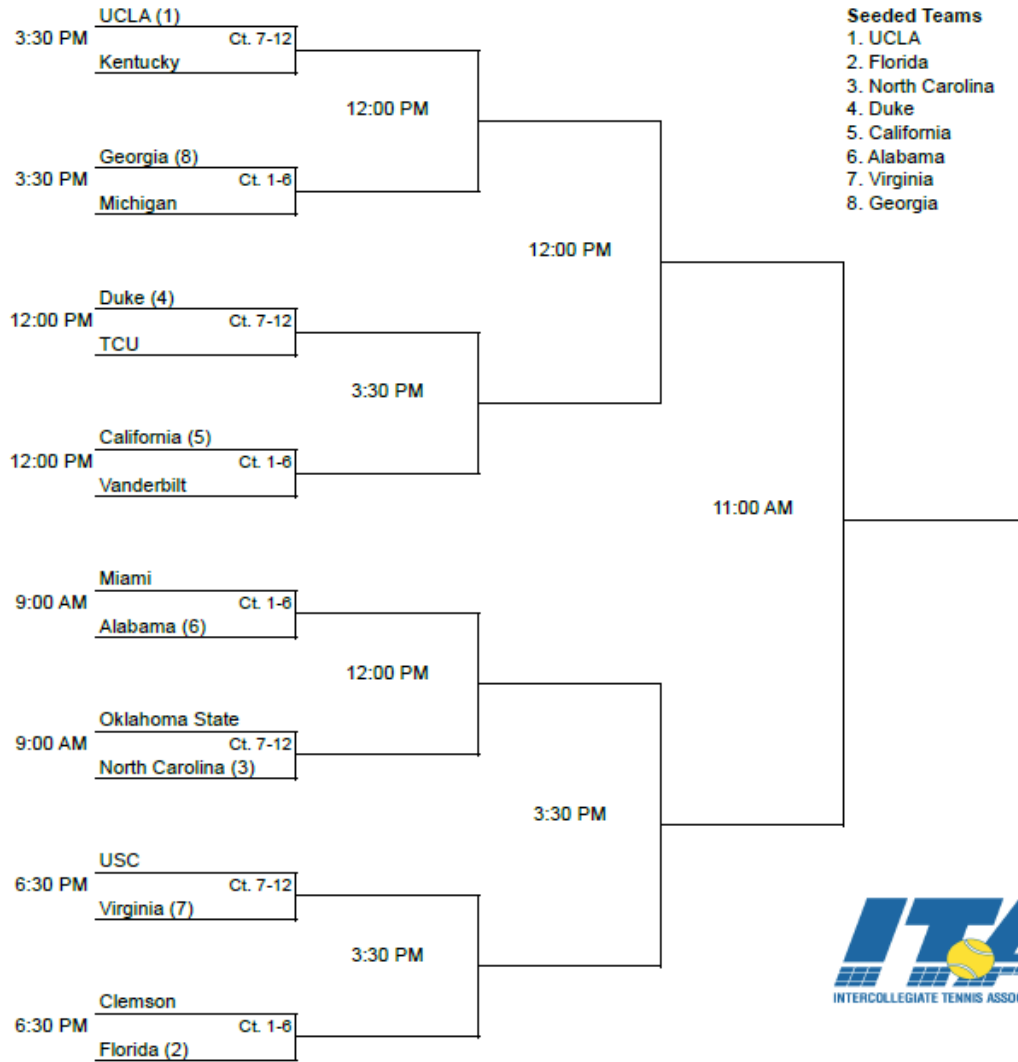
